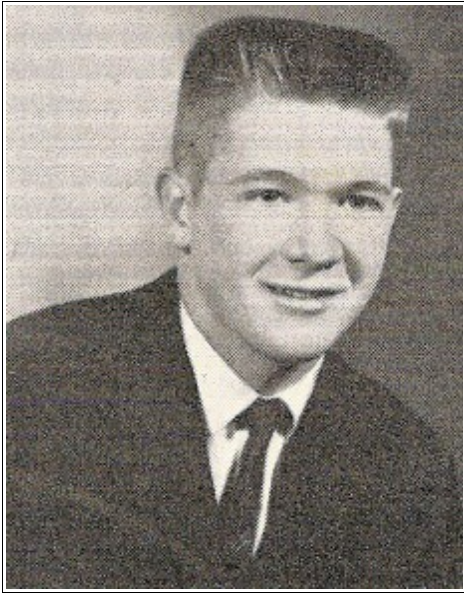


## Robert Lahm Simpson
